Brian Redway grew up between the DMV and New Jersey and learned business the hands-on way. In 2021 he started in short-term rentals and grew his own rental-arbitrage business to five properties. He then became operations project manager for a co-hosting company, a sister company to BNB Accelerator, where he onboarded and managed 70+ luxury properties nationwide and led a team of 10 virtual assistants. He wrote the book *Beyond the Booking*.

Those years taught him that a business only works when its systems work. He carried that into wholesale real estate and then into his work as a licensed REALTOR® in Washington, DC, with All Service Real Estate. He passed his licensing exam studying with Google's NotebookLM. Today he is also Senior Construction Consultant with G11 Construction and has taken part in 4 fix-and-flips in the last year.

As Principal Consultant at Redway AI, Brian has built more than 40 client automations, including a digital business card system (cards.redway.ai). He speaks on what AI actually changes for the people doing the work, and was featured in The Washington Informer's coverage of the DC Chamber of Commerce's Future-Ready Forum.
